CONSIDERED AS RAGGING

- Disrupts or disturbs the academic activity of junior students
- Financial Extortion
- Forceful Expenditure burden
- Abuse by spoken words, emails, snails-mail, blogs, public insults
- Deriving Perverted Pleasure
- Sadistic Thrill
- Affects the Mental Health and Self Confidence of Students
- Injury caused to the fundamental Right to Human Dignity through Humiliation

PHYSICAL ABUSE

- Sexual abuse
- Homosexual assaults
- Stripping
- Forcing obscene
- Lewd acts
- Gestured
- Bodily harm
- Danger to health

PUNISHMENT

- Cancellation of Admission
- Suspension from Attending Classes, Hostel
- Withholding, Drawing Scholarship, Fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national and international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- Rustication for period from 1 to 4 Semesters
- Debarring from Admission to any other Institution
- If ragging is proved, range from Suspension to Expulsion to a fine which can go up to Rs. 2,50,000/-

COLLECTIVE PUNISHMENT

- When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the Institution will resort to collective punishment as deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggars.
